2023-2024 **18 LPS Schools have requested to add 1 or more co-teaching teams**

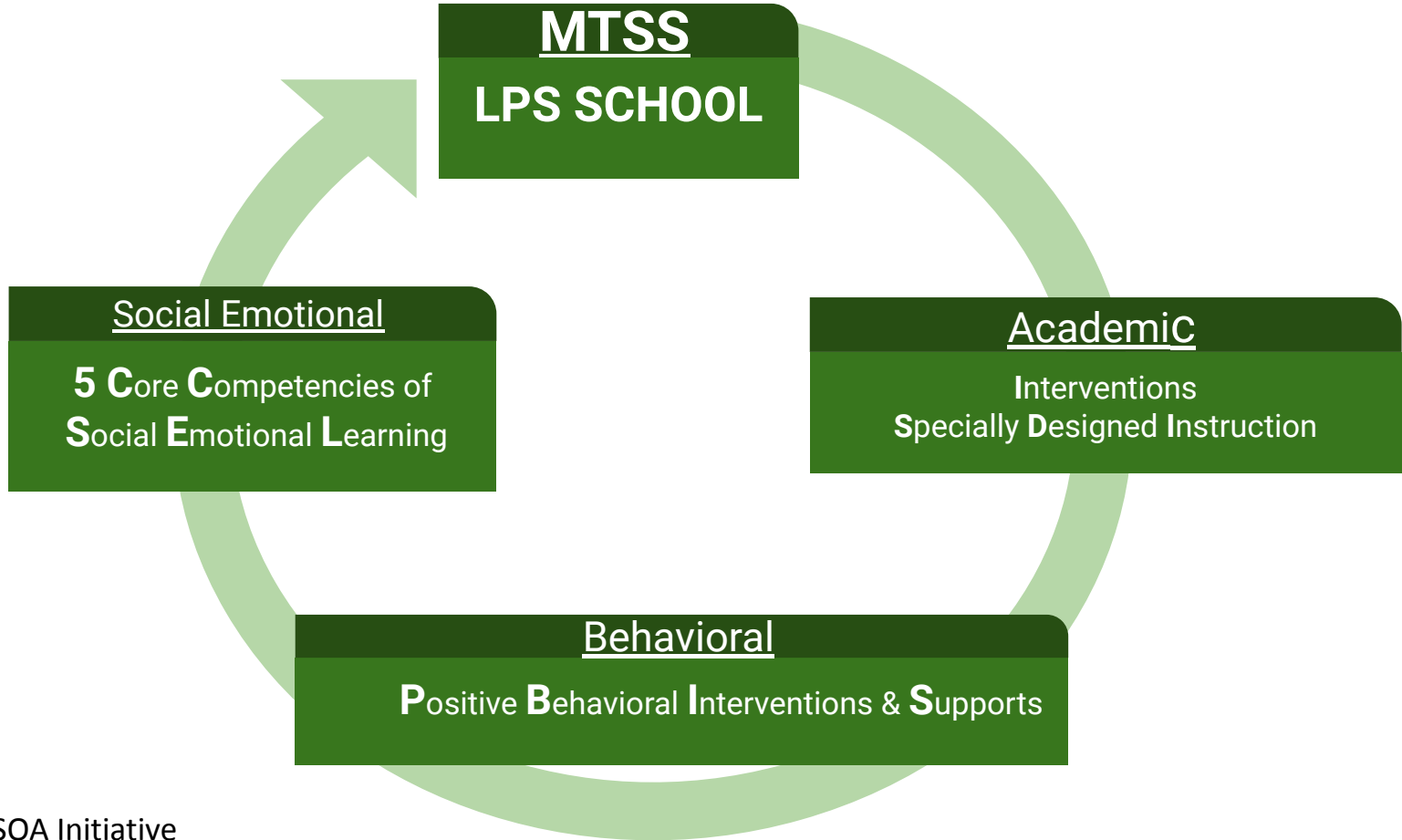

Behavioral Health 2022-2023 Highlights

- 27 Schools have a Student Support Teams which is comprised of Counselor(s), Behavior Specialists, Cultural Specialist, Restorative Justice Specialist, Board Certified Behavior Analysts (BCBA).
- 3 District Wide Student Support Teams which consist of: Teacher Classroom Behavioral Coach, 2 Behavior Specialists, and a Counselor
- 30 BCBA Positions
- 114 Counselor Positions
- Safety-Care De-escalation Practices
- Restorative Justice/Practices-Tier I, II, III
- School Training in Response to Instruction and Intervention (RTII)
